

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING GENERAL DRAYING AND OPERATING OF BILLARD AND POOL HALLS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Village Council of the Village of Moose Lake, Minnesota, do ordain as follows;

Section 1. All persons, firms, or corporation doing or desiring to do a general hauling or draying or transfer business as to the general public, within the Village limits, shall first obtain a license soto do from the Village Council and shall pay to said Village therefor the sum of ten dollars (\$ 10.00) such license fee to be for a period of one year or fraction thereof, from May 1st and shall be payable in advance.

Section 2. All persons, firms, corporations conducting or desiring to conduct a Billard or Pool Hall within the Village Limits, shall obtain from the Village Council a license so to do, and shall pay to said Village therefor the sum of ten dollars (\$ 10.00) for each and every billard or pool table for a period of one year, or fraction thereof, from May 1st and shall be payable in advance.

Section 3. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not less than five (5.00) dollars nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and costs, or imprisonment in the County jail, for not less than five days nor more than three months.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after May 1, 1927
