

ORDINANCE NO. 24a

AMENDMENT OF SECTION 7, OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 24, OF THE VILLAGE OF MOOSE LAKE, MINNESOTA, RELATING TO THE SALE OF NON*INTOXICATING MALT LIQUOR.

The village council of the village of Moose Lake does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 7 of Ordinance no. 24 of the village of Moose Lake, in Carlton County, Minnesota, shall be amended to read as follows:

No sales of non-intoxicating malt liquor shall be made on Sunday between one o'clock A.M. and six o'clock A.M., nor on any week day between 12:01 A.M. and the hour of the closing of the polls, nor shall any dancing be permitted at any time in any room, place or building where such malt liquors are at any time sold.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be enforced from and after the time of its passage.
