

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 24 - SECTION 6 - $\frac{1}{2}$

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF NON-INTOXICATING
MALT LIQUORS

The Village Council of the Village of Moose Lake, Carlton County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows: -

Section 1. SALE TO AND CONSUMPTION BY MINORS.

No non-intoxicating malt liquor shall be sold or served to any minor person, nor shall any minor person be permitted or allowed to consume any non-intoxicating malt liquor on the premises of any licensee within the Village of Moose Lake.

Anyone guilty of an infringement of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 2. RIGHT TO SEARCH AND SEIZE.

Any peace officer shall have the unqualified right to enter, inspect and search the premises of a licensee hereunder, during business hours, without a search and seizure warrant, and seize all intoxicating liquors found on the premises of such licensee, unless such licensee has an intoxicating liquor license issued under the provisions of Chapter 46, Extra Session Laws of 1933-34, and act amendatory thereof.

Section 3.

This amended ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
