

Zoning ordinance for gasoline filling stations for the village of Moose Lake, Minnesota.

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMOTING SAFETY, ORDER, CONVENIENCE, AND GENERAL WELFARE, BY REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE USE OF LAND, THE LOCATION, CONSTRUCTION AND USE AND ARRANGEMENT OF BUILDINGS AND LOTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, ESTABLISHMENT AND USE OF GASOLINE FILLING STATIONS IN THE VILLAGE OF MOOSE LAKE, MINNESOTA

The council of the village of Moose Lake, Minnesota, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Gasoline Filling Station Restrictions: No gasoline filling station shall hereafter be erected, constructed or maintained within the present fire zone within five hundred feet of a present gasoline filling station, or within fifteen hundred feet of a present gasoline filling station outside of the present fire zone and within the village limits of said village of Moose Lake.

Section 2. Curb Gasoline Pump Restrictions: No gasoline filling station, garage or other business shall hereafter erect, construct or maintain curb gasoline pumps within the village limits of said village of Moose Lake.

Section 3. Exceptions: This ordinance shall not apply to present gasoline filling stations or garages now operating and doing business within said village, or to gasoline filling stations or garages now maintaining curb service pumps within said village.

Section 4. Enforcement and Administration: Any person who shall violate or refuse to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject, upon conviction thereof, to a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars or imprisonment of not more than ninety days for each offense. Each day that the violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

Sub-section A. Should any section, provision, clause, or phrase of this ordinance be held to be invalid in the courts, such decision shall not be invalidating of any other parts of this ordinance.

Sub-section B. This act shall take effect and be enforced from and after its adoption as an ordinance.
