

ORDINANCE NO. 27.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A DUMPING GROUND AND REGULATING
THE DISPOSAL OF REFUSE THEREIN IN THE VILLAGE OF MOOSE LAKE.

Be it enacted by the Village Council of said Village of Moose
Lake, as follows:

Section 1. That portion of Government Lot Two (2), Section
Twenty - one (21), Township forty-six (46), Range nineteen (19)
Which lies north of the public read across said government lot
which said road extends easterly from the eastern termination
of Seventh Street in said Village, which is marked off by signs
and stakes, is hereby declared to be a public dumping ground and
no persons shall dump ashes, refuse, or other material elsewhere
on any private lands, or other public grounds or streets in said
village where the same would be unsightly or injurious to the
general health of the community.

Section 2. Whoever shall offend against the provisions of this
ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than
\$ 3.00, nor than \$ 25.00 together with costs, of prosection, and
in default of the payment of such fine and costs, be imprisoned
in the Village jail or County jail for a period of not to
exceed thirty days.
