

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A VILLAGE DUMPING GROUNDS AND REGULATING THE USE AND MAINTENANCE THEREOF

The Village Council of the Village of Moose Lake, Carlton County, Minnesota, do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. A Municipal dumping ground for the Village of Moose Lake, Carlton County, Minnesota is hereby established on that parcel of land lying in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$), of Section 31, Township 46, Range 19, Carlton County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of said Southeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ or SW $\frac{1}{4}$), of said Section Thirty-one (31), thence proceeding north along the east line of said Southeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$), a distance of Five Hundred (500) feet; thence west along a line parallel with the southern boundary line of said Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$), a distance of Four Hundred Twenty-five (425) feet; thence south along a line drawn parallel to the east forty line of said Southeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Thence along the south forty line of said Southeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$), to the place of beginning.

Section 2. A caretaker, to be appointed by the Village Council of the Millage of Moose Lake, shall supervise the use of the municipal dumping ground, and carry out and enforce all of the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3. No person shall deposit on the municipal dumping ground, any garbage or other putrescible matter unless it is securely covered by at least 24 inches of earth, or ashes, provided that permission may be granted by the Council, during the winter time or when the ground is solidly frozen, to deposit such matter without covering, and the same shall be covered by the municipality as soon as weather conditions permit.

Section 4. All deposits at the dumping grounds of tin cans or other vessels capable of holding water, and of loose paper or material which might be carried away by the wind, shall be covered with or ashes. No dead animals shall be deposited on the dumping ground.

Section 5. No person shall start any fire at the municipal dumping grounds nor deposit any hot ashes or other material likely to start a fire, without securing permit from the caretaker in charge of said dumping grounds.

Section 6. No person shall pick over the refuse deposited in the municipal dumping grounds for purposes of securing junk or any other reason, except by the permission of and under the supervision of the dumping caretaker.

Section 7. The caretaker of the dumping grounds shall be responsible to see that the fact of the working fill be kept as narrow as is consistent with proper operation of trucks and equipment in order that the area of waste material exposed be kept at a

minimum. All exposed surfaces should be covered with earth as promptly as is consistent with proper operations, and the final covering of earth for surface and side slopes should be maintained at a depth of approximately 24 inches. Proper inspection for and control of rodents shall be maintained by the caretaker.

Section 8. No person or persons shall dump or deposit ashes, rubbish or other refuse or debris upon the roadway of the Village dumping ground, or upon any other portion thereof upon which dumping is prohibited or forbidden.

Section 9. All residents of the Village of Moose Lake, and all residents of the Township of Moose Lake, Carlton County, Minnesota, shall have the right and the privilege of dumping refuse or garbage in said dumping ground, but all said individuals must at all times adhere to and be subject to the regulations of this ordinance.

Section 10. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not less than \$10.00, or more than \$100.00, or by imprisonment in the County jail for not less than 10 nor more than 90 days, or both.

Section 11. This ordinance shall take effect from and after the passage of and publication of the same, according to law.
