

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ADVISORY AIRPORT COMMISSION OF MOOSE LAKE
AND DEFINING ITS DUTIES.

The Village Council of Moose Lake, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Airport Commission Established. There is hereby established a non-salaried airport advisory commission to be known as the Municipal Airport Commission of Moose Lake. It shall be composed of three (3) members appointed by the Mayor from among citizens interested in the development and utilization of the municipal airport. The Mayor of the Council shall designate one of the members as Chairman. Of the members first appointed, one shall serve for a term of one year, one for a term of two years, and one for term of three years, or until their successors, have appointed and qualified. A vacancy shall be filled by the Mayor for the unexpired term.

Section 2. Meetings and Reports. The commission may make and alter such rules and regulations for its government and the conduct of its business as consistent with the laws relating to Villages and the ordinance of the Village of Moose Lake. It shall meet at least once each month or oftener, on the call of the Chairman, or a majority of its members, and it shall keep an accurate record of all the proceedings which shall be furnished to members of the Village Council, as soon after of the commission as practicable. In the month of January of each year it shall make and file with the Village Council, a full report of its transactions for the preceding year.

Section 3 Duties. The commission shall plan, promote, and encourage the development and utilization of the municipal airport. It shall advise the council, both with respect to general policies and detail administration, in all matters having to do with the acquisition, construction, improvement, maintenance, operation, management and control of the municipal airport and all appurtenances thereto, and shall advise the council with respect to the airport budget, the charges and other financial arrangements for the use of the airport property, as well as recommendation for the zoning and protection of aerial approaches. It shall have the further duty of consulting and cooperation, financial and otherwise, with respect to the airport.

Section 4 Administrative Control. Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed as taking away from the Village Council any of its governmental powers or its authority to manage the municipal airport, personnel, funds, and properties.

Section 5. Effective Time. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
