

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VILLAGE ORDINANCE NUMBER 36, WHICH ESTABLISHED THE VILLAGE DUMPING GROUNDS AND REGULATING THE USE AND MAINTENANCE THEREOF BY PROHIBITING THE SHOOTING OF FIREARMS ON SAID DUMP GROUNDS.

The Village Council of the Village of Moose Lake, Carlton County, Minnesota, does hereby ordain as follows:

Ordinance Number 36, entitled " Ordinance Establishing a Village Dumping Grounds and Regulating the use and Maintenance Thereof", is hereby amended to add the following section:

Section 12, No person shall discharge any firearms upon , into, or on the property owned by the village of Moose Lake and described in Ordinance Number 36, or to target practice or to shoot any animate or inanimate thing or item on said premises without the permission of the superintendent of the dumping grounds or the Chief of Police for the Village of Moose Lake. Any persons violating the provision of this Section, shall be punishable by the terms of said Ordinance number 36.
