

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SALE OF NON-INTOXICATING MALT LIQUORS AND INTOXICATING LIQUORS, PROVIDING FOR CLOSING HOURS AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 24 AND NO. 25, VILLAGE OF MOOSE LAKE, CARLTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

The Village Council of the Village of Moose Lake, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Village Ordinance No. 24 of the Village of Moose Lake, Minnesota is hereby amended to read as follows:

No sale of non-intoxicating liquors shall be made on any Sunday between the hours of one A.M. and twelve o'clock noon, nor between the hours of one A.M. and eight o'clock P.M. on any election day in the district in which the election shall be held. No sale be made between the hours of one A.M. and eight o'clock A.M. on any week day Monday through Saturday inclusive.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 25 of the Village of Moose Lake, Minn., is hereby amended to read as follows:

No sale of intoxicating liquors shall be made after one A.M. on Sunday, nor between the hours of one A.M. and three o'clock P.M. on any Memorial Day, nor between the hours of one A.M. and eight o'clock P.M. on any election Day, in the district in which such election shall be held. No "on sale" shall be made between the hours of one A.M. and eight o'clock A.M. on any week day. No "off sale" shall be made before eight o'clock A.M. or after ten o'clock P.M. of any day. No "off sale" shall be made on New Years Day, January 1st; Memorial Day, May 30th; Independence Day, July 4th; Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day, December 25th; but on the evening preceding such days "off sale" may be made until ten o'clock P.M. except that no "off sale" shall be made on December 24th after eight o'clock P.M. No "on sale" place of business shall be permitted to have swinging doors or opaque windows. All sales shall be made in full view of the public. No intoxicating liquor shall be sold or furnished for any purpose to any person under the age of 21 years or to an habitual drunkard or to any person obviously intoxicated or to any of the persons to whom sale is prohibited by statute or by reason of sale to whom penalty is provided by statute.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the passage and publication thereof in accordance with the law.
