

An ordinance regulating the parking of automobiles in streets after a snow storm, and amending ordinance #34 entitled "An Ordinance regulating the use of highways in the Village of Moose Lake, Carlton County, Minnesota, and imposing penalties for the violation thereof."

The Village Council of the Village of Moose Lake, Carlton County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance # 34, dated April 7th, 1942, and entitled "An Ordinance regulating the use of hohgways in the Village of Moose Lake, Carlton County, Minnesota, and imposing penalties for the violation thereof," is hereby amended so as to add an additional section to be designated as Section 25 in said ordinance, and made a part thereof, to read as follows:

"Parking on any public street in the Village of Moose Lake, is hereby prohibited for forty-eight (48) hours following a snowstorm, so that all streets may be cleared of vehicles for snow plowing and snow removal from said streets."

Section 2. Penalties provided by Ordinance No. 34 will be applicable to a violation of the new section of said ordinance as provided by this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take affect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
