

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING
THE USE OF TRAILERS AS PERMANENT RESIDENCES

A. The Village Council of the Village of Moose Lake, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or corporation to permit, allow or maintain at any time in the future a so-called Automobile trailer or any other type of trailer used ordinarily for temporary use to be installed or set up in the Village of Moose Lake as a permanent residence, or for temporary use as a home.

SECTION 2. No water or sewer shall be furnished by the Village of Moose Lake to any such trailer house which any person may attempt to use for a temporary or permanent residence.

SECTION 3. An automobile trailer, trailer coach, or trailer means any vehicle or structure so designed and constructed as to permit occupancy thereof as sleeping quarters for one or more persons or conduct of any business or profession, occupation or trade and so designed that it or may be mounted on wheels and used as a conveyance on highways or city streets, propelled or drawn by its own or other motive power, excepting a device used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be considered as an amendment to the building code ordinance now in force and effect in the Village of Moose Lake.

SECTION 5. Any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and any person convicted thereof shall be fined by a fine of not more than \$ 100.00 or imprisoned in the County jail for not more than 90 days.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
