

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF THOSE WHO ENGAGE
IN THE INSTALLATION OF GAS APPLIANCES

The Village Council of the Village of Moose Lake, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

1. Whereas, the Village of Moose Lake is now receiving natural gas from the Iron Ranges Natural Gas Company, and the Council feels it advisable for reasons of health and safety, to license and control the individuals, corporations or those who install gas furnaces and appliances and who do repair work in connection with the use of same, the Council therefore promulgates the following rules and regulations as hereinafter set out:

2. All installation and repair work must conform to the standards of the following agencies:

- (a) The American Gas Association.
- (b) The National Board of Fire Underwriters.
- (c) Rules and regulations furnished by the Iron Ranges Natural Gas Company and agreed to by the Moose Lake Village Council.

3. Instructions in the following named publication shall be recognized as covering paragraph number 2a and 2b above set forth:

(a) Guide for installers of gas central heating systems, conversion burners, floor furnaces, vented space heaters and unit heaters issued by the gas house committee residential section of the American Gas Association, revised in 1955.

(b) Metalbestos gas vent installation hand book for correct venting of gas appliances, put out by the Metalbestos Division, William Wallace Company, Belmont, California, Bulletin number 100 Copyrighted 1959 by the William Wallace Company.

4. All Persons, Corporations or those installing any kind of gas furnace, heaters, appliances, or equipment of any kind or making repairs thereon, which will require the use of natural gas in its operation or use, shall pay a license fee in the sum of \$10.00 to Village Clerk of the Village of Moose Lake, prior to any such installation or repair work above referred to such permit to be renewed annually at an annual fee of \$10.00.

5. In addition to the license fee above set forth and required, any such person, corporation or others engaged in the installation or repair of the equipment and appliances as above set forth, shall furnish to the Village Clerk a surety bond in the sum of \$1,000.00 to be filed with the Village Clerk at the time of the application for the permit.

6. Each such applicant shall also furnish to the Village Clerk copies of public liability and property damage insurance policies for the life of each such license. Public liability insurance shall not be less than \$50,000.00 for injuries including accidental death of one person and subject to the same limitations for each person in an amount of not less than \$100,000.00 on account of one accident and property damage insurance in the amount of not less than \$25,000.00.

7. Any such equipment or appliances so installed or repair work done must have the approval of the Iron Ranges Natural Gas Company prior to the use of such appliances or installations.
