

ORDINANCE NO. 55

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF THOSE WHO ENGAGE IN THE INSTALLATION OF GAS APPLIANCES

The Village Council of the Village of Moose Lake, Minnesota do ordain as follows:

The ordinance providing for the licensing of those who engage in the installation of gas appliances, passed by the Village Council of Moose Lake, Minnesota, on November 2nd, 1959, and published in the Star Gazette, the official paper of the village, on November 26th, 1959, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraphs to said ordinance:

Section 8. The Iron Range Natural Gas Company shall refuse gas service to the premises wherein any gas fired installation or connection or repairs made contrary to the terms of this ordinance, upon discovery of the same until the same has been disconnected, removed or repaired.

Section 9. Any person who shall authorize or contract for or perform work in connection with the installation or connection or repair of gas fired apparatus or equipment contrary to the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction, be punished by fine and not exceeding \$100.00 or by imprisonment for a term of not exceeding 90 days.

Adopted by the Council this 7th day of November, 1959, & published in the Star Gazette, Moose Lake, Minnesota, on December 10th, 1959.
