

ORDINANCE NO. 62

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COMBINATION OF THE OFFICES OF VILLAGE CLERK
AND VILLAGE TREASURER AND PROVIDING FOR ANNUAL VILLAGE AUDITS

The village council of Moose Lake, Minnesota, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority granted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 412.02, Subdivision 3, the offices of clerk and treasurer in the village of Moose Lake, Carlton County, Minnesota, are hereby combined in the office of Clerk-Treasurer.

Section 2. Beginning with the year in which this ordinance becomes effective and each year thereafter, there shall be an audit of the village financial affairs by the Public Examiner or a Public Accountant in accordance with minimum auditing procedures prescribed by the public examiner.

Section 3. This ordinance is effective at the expiration of the term of the incumbent treasurer.
