

ORDINANCE NO. 69

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE
THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE OF 1968

The Village Council of the Village of Moose Lake do ordain as follows:

1. The Village Council of the Village of Moose Lake does hereby adopt by reference as an Ordinance and as a Code for the Village of Moose Lake, Minnesota the National Electric Code of 1968, as sponsored by the National Fire Protection Association, under the auspices of the United States of America Standards Institute, and any later amendments thereto.

2. The above code is adopted by the Village Council of the Village of Moose Lake by reference, word for word, paragraph for paragraph and chapter for chapter, as if the same had been fully set out herein.

3. Be it further ordained that notwithstanding anything heretofore said in this ordinance any sections in said Code, concerning any charges or fees set forth in the Code are not adopted by this ordinance and the Village Council hereby reserves to itself the power by motion and the minutes of said Council to recommend any schedule of fees and charges for any services that may call for a fee or charge in said code.

Passed by the Village Council for the Village of Moose Lake this 9th day of December, 1968, in the Village of Moose Lake, Minnesota.
