

An ordinance regulating the presence of miners under the age of seventeen (17) years on the streets or in public places between the hours of 10:30 P.M. and 5:00 a.m. except that on Friday and Saturday evenings the hours shall be between 12:00 P.M. and 5:00A.M., defining the duties of parents and others having the care of miners and providing for penalties for violations thereof.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MOOSE LAKE DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any miner under the age of seventeen (17) years to loiter, idle or be upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, parks, playgrounds or other public grounds, public places and public buildings, places of amusement, entertainment, or refreshments, vacant lots or other unsupervised places between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 5:00 A.M. except that on Friday and Saturday evenings the hours shall be between 12 P.M. and 5 A.M. of the following day; provided however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to any such minor accompanied by his parent, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor or when the minor is upon an errand directed by his or her parent, gaurdian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for the parent, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of a minor under the age of seventeen (17) years to permit such minor to loiter, idle, or be in or upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, parks, playgrounds or other public grounds, public places and public buildings, places of amusement, entertainmaent, or refreshment, vacant lots or other unsupervised places between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 5:00 A.M. except that on Friday and Saturday evenings the hours shall be between 12 P.M. and 5 A.M. of the following day; provided however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply when the minor is accompanied by his parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor or when the minor is upon an errand directed by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation operating or in charge of any place of amusement, entertainment or refreshment to permit any minor under the age of seventeen (17) years to enter or remain in such place during the hours prohibited by this ordinance; provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply when such minor is accompanied by his or her parent, gaurfdian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor.

Section 5. Any minor under the age of 17 years who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed a delinquent child as defined in Minnesota Statures 1941, Section 260.01.

Section 6. Any parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of a minor under the age of 17 years who shall violate the Provision Section 2 hereof shall upon conviction be fined not more than three hundred (\$300) dollars or by imprisonment not exceeding 90 days.

Section 7. Any person, firm or corporation operating or in charge of any places of amusement, entertainment, or refreshment who shall violate the provisions of Section 3 of this ordinance shall, upon conviction be fined not more than Three Hundred (\$300) dollars or by imprisonment not exceeding 90 days.

Section 8. Each separate provision of this ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein, and if any provision of this ordinance be declared invaled, all other provisions thereof shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section 9. Any other ordinances or parts of ordinance inconsistent with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed.

Section 10. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty days after its passage and publication.
