

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
A COMMISSION TO PLAN FOR THE PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT
OF THE CITY OF MOOSE LAKE, MINNESOTA, AND TO
RECOMMEND A ZONING PLAN

THE CITY COUNCIL OF MOOSE LAKE, MINNESOTA,
DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 2 of the Ordinance Establishing a Commission to Plan for the Physical Development of the City of Moose Lake, Minnesota, and to Recommend a Zoning Plan, as amended, be amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. Composition. Such Planning Commission shall consist of five (5) members. Four (4) members shall be appointed by the City Council and may be removed by a four-fifths (4/5) vote of the Council; the City Mayor shall be a member ex officio. The Council shall select at least one of the members of the Commission from its own members. All 5 members of the Commission shall have the right to vote. In addition, the Commission so appointed shall select two (2) non-voting residents of Moose Lake Township as advisory members, and the City Attorney and City Engineer shall also act as advisory members.

Of the members of the Commission first appointed, one shall be appointed for the term of one (1) year, one for the term of two (2) years, one for the term of three (3) years, and one for the term of four (4) years. Their successors shall be appointed for terms of four (4) years. Both original and successive appointees shall hold their offices until their successors are appointed and qualified. The terms of the ex officio members shall correspond to his respective official tenure. Vacancies during the term shall be filled by the Council for the unexpired portion of the term. Every appointed member shall, before entering upon the discharge of his duties, take an oath that he will faithfully discharge the duties of his office. All members shall serve without compensation."
