

ORDINANCE NO. 103 - B

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 93, PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT AND MAKING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE GOVERNMENT OF THE SAME.

The City Council of Moose Lake Minnesota, does ordain as follows:

Ordinance No. 93 entitled: Providing for the establishment of a Volunteer Fire Department and making rules and regulations for the government of the same, shall be amended as follows:

Section 7: The Firemen shall be not less than nineteen, nor more than thirty-five years of age and able bodied at the time of enlistment in the Department. They shall pass a satisfactory mental and physical examination and shall become members of the Fire Department only after a six-months probationary period.

Section 8: Firemen with three unexcused absences from meetings and/or drills in any twelve-month period shall constitute grounds for dismissal from benefits and membership in the department, pending vote of the membership.
