

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PARK BOARD

Section 1. Formation of Park Board.

(a.) There is hereby established in the City of Moose Lake, a Park Board, which shall operate in accordance with this Ordinance.

(b.) The Park Board shall consist of three (3) members, to be appointed by the Mayor with the consent of the City Council.

(c.) One member of the original board shall be a council member whose term shall be for one year. The council member appointment shall be filled each year during the annual committee appointment process. One member of the original board shall serve for a term of one year, one member of the board shall serve for a term of two years. Thereafter, one shall be appointed for a term of two (2) years each year. Vacancies shall be filled for the remainder of the original terms by appointment of the Mayor with the consent of the City Council.

(d.) Members of the Park Board shall serve without compensation unless the council authorizes compensation which may not exceed \$100 per year for each member. When no compensation is allowed, each member shall be entitled to a reasonable reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses incurred.

(e.) Any member may be removed by the Mayor with the consent of the City Council for cause after a hearing.

Section 2. Organization and Procedure.

(a.) The Board shall choose one of its members as Chairman.

(b.) The Board may adopt and from time to time amend Rules of Procedure.

(c.) The Board shall make annual reports of its activities to the City Council.

Section 3. Control of Park Activities.

(a.) The Park Board shall have full recommendation powers on all activities occurring on City Park property.

Section 4. Power of the Park Board.

(a.) The Park Board shall insure that park property is maintained, beautified and cared for.

(b.) The Park Board may perform whatever other acts that are reasonable, necessary and proper to carry out the powers above set forth.

Section 5. Park Funds.

(a.) For the purpose of carrying out the powers of the Park Board, there shall be established a special fund to be called a "Park Fund".

Section 5 continued-

(b.) The City Council may transfer to the Park Fund such monies as it shall consider necessary for park purposes.

(c.) Not later than August 1st of each year the Park Board shall present to the Council in such detail as the Council shall require its annual estimate of financial needs of the Board for the ensuing fiscal year and shall as a part of such estimate submit a budget outlining proposed expenditures.

Section 6. Effective Date.

(a.) This Ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and Publication.
