

The City Council of the City of Moose Lake, Carlton County, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. PURPOSE.

It is the purpose of the City Council of the City of Moose Lake to protect the public health and welfare by proscribing certain activities, which by their very nature, could result in harm to people, property, and animals.

Section 2. PROHIBITIONS.

A. No person shall fire or discharge any firearm, rifle or pistol which propels a projectile by gunpowder, compressed air, or other means within the corporate limits of the City of Moose Lake.

B. No person shall fire a bow, cross-bow, sling-shot, or any instrument capable of propelling a projectile through the air within the corporate limits of the City of Moose Lake.

C. No person shall send up any balloon or other fireworks exhibit or throw stones or missiles nor carry any fireworks within the corporate limits of the City of Moose Lake.

D. No person shall cause to set out any injurious trap or poison capable of access by any person or animal outside a building within the corporate limits of the City of Moose Lake.

Section 3. EXCEPTIONS.

The Chief of Police or his designate may issue a written permit allowing the use of any of the proscribed acts upon the showing of the need to use any such devices for the public health and welfare or for approved community events subject to any and all limitations the Chief of Police or his designate may deem necessary, including, but not limited to, what act may be used, location, and duration.

Section 4. SEVERABILITY.

If any part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment or decree shall not affect or impair the remainder of this ordinance.

Section 5. PENALTY.

Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$700.00, or by imprisonment in jail for not more than ninety (90) days, or both.

Section 6. REPEAL.

Ordinance Number 4, of the City of Moose Lake is hereby repealed.

Section 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
