

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR
REGULATION OF CEMETERY VISITORS

The City Council of Moose Lake, Minnesota, does hereby
ordain:

Section 1. No person may obstruct any drive or path in the cemetery or in any way injure, deface or destroy any structure, grave, tree, or other thing in the cemetery without written permission from the City Council or its designated agent.

Section 2. No person may drive any vehicle at an excessive speed within the cemetery, nor drive over any path or roadway not authorized by the City Council.

Section 3. No person may use the cemetery grounds or any road therein as a public thoroughfare, nor drive any vehicle through the cemetery grounds except for purposes relating to the cemetery.


Section 4. No person may disturb the quiet of the cemetery by noise or improper conduct of any kind.

Section 5. No person may possess or consume any intoxicating or non-intoxicating liquor or beer in the cemetery at any time.

Section 6. No person may loiter at any time, nor be in the cemetery without written permission of the City Council or its designated agent at any time between the hours of sunset to 7 o'clock A.M.

Section 7. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$700.00, and/or by imprisonment for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days.
