

ORDINANCE NO. 139

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBDIVISION 1, AND SUBDIVISION 2, OF ORDINANCE NO. 137, AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD FOR, AND IN, THE CITY OF MOOSE LAKE, MINNESOTA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOOSE LAKE:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Subdivision 1, and Subdivision 2, of Ordinance No. 137, which establishes a Public Library Board.

SECTION 2:

Subdivision 1 of Ordinance No. 137 is hereby repealed and the following is substituted in its place:

Subdivision 1. *Number of Members.* The library board shall consist of five (5) members all having full voting privileges. Four (4) members shall be residents of the City of Moose Lake. One (1) member shall be a resident of Carlton County. All members shall be appointed by the Mayor with the consent of the City Council.

Subdivision 2 of Ordinance No. 137 is hereby repealed and the following is substituted in its place:

Subdivision 2. *Term of Office.* Of the four (4) City members, one (1) shall be a City Council person whose term on the library board shall be for a period of one (1) year. The Carlton County resident appointment shall also be for a period of one (1) year. The City Council representative and the Carlton County resident appointment shall be made each year during the annual committee appointment process of the City Council. Of the three (3) remaining City members, two (2) shall serve for a term of two (2) years and one (1) shall serve for a term of one (1) year. Thereafter, with the exception of the City Council representative and the Carlton County resident, members shall be appointed or re-appointed to the library board and shall serve for a term of three (3) years. A library board member shall not be eligible to serve more than three (3) consecutive three (3) year terms. Vacancies shall be filled by the City Council for the remainder of that original term. Members shall serve until a successor is appointed and qualified. Any member may be removed by the Mayor with the consent of the City Council, but only after a hearing for cause.

SECTION 3.


In all other respects, Ordinance No. 137 as previously passed and its provisions shall remain in full force and effect. This Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 137 shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication according to law.
