

ORDINANCE #160

AN ORDINANCE OPTING-OUT OF
THE REQUIREMENTS OF
MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593

SECTION 1.

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2016, Governor Dayton signed into law the creation and regulation of temporary family health care dwellings, codified at Minn. Stat. § 462.3593, which permit and regulate temporary family health care dwellings;

WHEREAS, subdivision 9 of Minn. Stat. §462.3593 allows cities to "opt out" of those regulations;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOOSE LAKE, ORDAINS as follows:


The City of Moose Lake opts-out of the requirements of Minn. Stat. §462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings.

SECTION 2.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance of the City of Moose Lake shall be effective upon its approval and summary publication which shall read as follows:
