

ORDINANCE NO. 110B
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 110 ALLOWING
SUNDAY OFF-SALES

The City Council of the City of Moose Lake, Minnesota, hereby ordains:

Ordinance No. 110, regulating the sale of 3.2 beer and malt liquor, is amended as follows:

1. At Section 2, Subdivision 7 is repealed and replaced as follows:

Section 2, Subdivision 7. Growler Off-Sale. A brewery licensed under Minn. Stat. Section 340A.301, may obtain a Growler Off-Sale license. The brewery is limited to producing less than 3,500 barrels of malt liquor per calendar year to qualify for the growler off-sale license. A growler is a 64 ounce container, filled on the brewery site, with product manufactured on the site. For growler off-sale operations, hours of sale are: Monday – Saturday 8:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and, commencing on July 1, 2017, on Sundays between the hours of 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., provided further no off-sales shall occur on Thanksgiving Day, or on Christmas Day, December 25. No growler off-sales shall take place on Christmas Eve, December 24, after 8 p.m.

2. This Amendment to Ordinance No. 110 shall take effect and be in full force from and after July 1, 2017, provided its passage and publication occurs thirty days prior to said date.
